The Lochnagar League Rules

The Lochnagar League is for bronze British Dressage & unaffiliated GDG members competing in the GDG competitions listed below (please check BD schedules for classes available on specific days, as not all levels are on both days):

- 11th January 2020 at Ladyleys Equestrian Centre
- 28th & 29th March 2020 at Cabin Equestrian Centre
- 2nd & 3rd May 2020 at Ladyleys Equestrian Centre
- 27th & 28th June 2020 at Cabin Equestrian Centre
- 25th & 26th July 2020 at Cabin Equestrian Centre
- 26th & 27th September 2020 at Ladyleys Equestrian Centre

To be eligible to win prizes, a horse/pony combination must attend a minimum of three of the listed competitions above – a two day competition is classed as two separate competitions

Your highest 5 results will be used to calculate your TOTAL points (points are allocated for % not placing)

The Lochnagar League points are gained in the Unaffiliated & Bronze sections (see section notes below for eligibility)

Any horse/pony changing riders during the league will not carry forward any points previously gained with the previous rider

Overall Junior Champion will be the junior with highest points, 1st – 6th for Junior League

Your points will be allocated after each competition, so there is no need for you to register your intent to compete in the leagues, as long as you are a fully paid up member you will be included. If you have any queries, please contact gordondressagegroup@gmail.com

Horses/ponies will be eligible to submit points at any one level for either Unaffiliated or Bronze sections, not both, and with one rider only

Boost Your Points, earn DOUBLE points in any of the North East Champion Classes at the May competition

Bronze Section - This is a BD affiliated section, and to compete you must enter the appropriate level according to BD rules

Unaffiliated Section - GDG unaffiliated sections are open to horses/ponies who have gained no more than 25 points at any level above they wish to compete

Horses who have previously competed at a higher level than they are currently competing at may only enter classes 2 levels below the highest level at which they have previously competed. Regardless of the rider. e.g. if a horse has competed at medium they can only enter the championships at Novice level or above

Horses/ponies which have been placed 1st in GDG dressage leagues or at the North East of Scotland Dressage Championships (held in May) in previous years may not compete in the Lochnagar League at that level or lower with the exception of Advanced Medium level and above

<u>Music Classes</u>: Unaffiliated: you compete at your level within the restrictions outlined above. Bronze Section - to compete you must be eligible & enter according to BD rules.
